Recently, FEMA called together three great private organizations which assist with disaster relief. The organizations were the American Red Cross, the Salvation Army, and the Church of Christ Disaster Relief Effort. During the first seven months of this year, the Churches of Christ Disaster Relief Effort responded to disasters of various kinds in eleven states and distributed nearly three million dollars worth of items to help.
